The financial results of the IPS Vantage Tech Services Private Limited [Wholly owned Subsidiary Company] for the half year and year ended 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2025, whose share of total assets, total revenues and net cash inflows / (outflows) are included in the consolidated financial results had been audited by other auditor, M/s R. Swaminathan & Co., and whose reports dated 15<sup>th</sup> May, 2025 have been furnished to us by the Company's management and auditor has expressed an unmodified conclusion on those financial results. These reports have been relied upon by ATSJ And Associates. for the purpose of the audit of consolidated financial results.

The consolidated financial results include the interim financial results of one foreign subsidiary which have not been reviewed by their auditors, whose interim financial results reflect, total income of Rs. Nil and Rs. Nil, total net profit / (loss) after tax of Rs. Nil for the half year and year ended March 31, 2025, respectively, as considered in the consolidated financial results. According to the information and explanation given to us by the Management, these interim financial results are not material to the Group.

The consolidated financial results include the share of profit/loss of the interim financial results of one foreign associate which have not been reviewed by their auditors, whose interim financial results reflect, total income of Rs. 147.01 Lakhs and Rs. (1.12), total net profit / (loss) after tax for the half year and year ended March 31, 2025, respectively, as considered in the consolidated financial results. According to the information and explanation given to us by the Management, these interim financial results are not material to the Group.

Our conclusion is not modified in respect of these matters.

Our opinion on the consolidated financial results is not modified in respect of the above matters with respect to our reliance on the work done and the report of other auditors and the financial results/ information certified by the board of directors.

The consolidated financial results for the half year ended 31st March, 2025 being the balancing figure between the audited figures in respect of the full financial year ended 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2025 and the published unaudited year-to-date figures up to the half year ended 30<sup>th</sup> September, 2024 of the current financial year, which were subjected to a limited review by us, as required under the Listing Regulations.
